First of all, we would like to inform you that we have decided to hold the EUMA General Assembly on 10 November 2018 in Brussels, Belgium. A main reason for this decision was that the EU Commission, under the aegis of Marco Onida will host a convention on 9 November where EUMA will be present as a partner for the first time.

On this occasion, we would like to thank Prof. Jurica Ugrinovski and the Macedonian Mountaineering Sport Federation for their application to host the GA. Also, we would like to thank our Belgian friends for their cooperation in organizing the GA in November.

You will receive the official invitation and all the details on the General Assembly, including information on hotel booking in due time.

The official registration of EUMA in Belgium is making progress. In this respect, we would like to thank all the member federations for unanimously consenting to the amendment of the Articles. In the meantime, the Articles have been translated into French, which was a further requirement for registration in Belgium. We now expect to have an appointment at the Belgian notary's office in the near future.

Further, we would like to thank you for payment of the membership fees.

Attached please find a document describing the relationship of EUMA and the UIAA on the basis of which the two organisations will collaborate in future.

Our next Board Meeting will take place next week in Tenerife on the invitation of the Council of Tourism of Tenerife. Information on the results of this meeting will be sent in June.
